Also present were Town Administrator Mark Graves, Town Recorder/Treasurer Chris Lowe, and Attorney Todd Moore.


Vice-Mayor Marion Joyce called the meeting to order at 1800.

Chris Lowe called roll with all members being present.

1. Approval of the Agenda
 - a. Alderman Faulkenberry motioned to approve the agenda, seconded by Alderman Morton with all members voting aye.
2. Approval of the Minutes
 - a. Alderman Faulkenberry motioned to approve the minutes, seconded by Alderman Sedlak with all members voting aye.
3. Citizen Input:
 - a. Steve Brewer, owner of Chapel Hill Wine & Spirits, was present and spoke about limiting the liquor stores in Chapel Hill. Currently, there is no limit on the amount of liquor stores and he requests that the limit be put back in place only allowing two liquor stores with the third store grandfathered in.
 - b. Jamie Pratt, from WJJM, was present and spoke about extending the Straight Talk session we recently sponsored on WJJM. Mark mentioned extending it for the rest of the fiscal year and then adding to the budget going forward.
