The Town of Chapel Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen is seeking a qualified individual to fill a vacant Alderman position within The Town of Chapel Hill. Qualified individuals with interest to fill the unexpired term of Alderman ending August 31, 2028, may submit a letter of interest. Letters may be mailed or hand delivered to Town Hall, 4650 Nashville Highway, Chapel Hill, TN 37034. Letters of interest may also be emailed to the Town Administrator, Phillip Dye at phillipdye@townofchapelhilltn.gov. Letters of interest are to be received on or before Thursday, March 26, 2026 at 5 PM.

Qualifications as specified in the Charter of the Town of Chapel Hill state that the corporate and legislative authority of the Town shall be vested in the Board. They shall reside in the Town at least one (1) year next to preceding their appointment and be not less than twenty-one (21) years of age when taking office. Before taking office, the Aldermen shall take an oath that they will faithfully and impartially discharge the duties pertaining to their office.
